## Subjects of Sentences: Complete Subject and Simple Subject

The part of the sentence that you have been writing is called the *complete subject*. There is always a main word in the complete subject. This main word is called the *simple subject*.

\*\*The <u>simple subject</u> is the main word in the complete subject.\*\*

- EXAMPLE The four new students arrived early. *Complete subject* The four new students *Simple subject* students
- EXAMPLE A round walnut table with five legs stood in the middle of the dining room. Complete subject A round walnut table with five legs Simple subject table

Note that the main word of the subject (*students, table*) cannot be omitted. Without this word the sentences do not make sense.

> The four new...arrived early. A round walnut...with five legs stood in the middle of the dining room.

When the subject is only one word, name, or title, the simple subject and the complete subject are the sam.

EXAMPLES Jets break the sound barrier. [one word] Aunt Carmen owns a grocery store. [name] Roll of Thunder, Hear My Cry is a novel by Mildred Taylor. [title]

In the last example, *Roll of Thunder, Hear My Cry* is the title of a single book; therefore, all the words in the title make up the simple subject; in this sentence, they are also the complete subject.
