

### Essay #3 Literary Analysis

You learned about many different changes that round characters undergo by reading "Gonzalo," "Thirteen and a Half," "Through the Tunnel," "The Captive Outfielder," and "Raymond's Run." These changes helped the characters gain a better understanding of the world around them.

In an essay, identify a round character from two of the stories and analyze how each character changes. Support your response with evidence (excerpts/quotes) from each story.

These are the steps that should be followed when writing a five paragraph essay:

- Read prompt 2-3x
- Circle action verbs and underline key words
- Brainstorm and choose topic/evidence
- Create an outline
- Write a rough draft
- Edit/revise rough draft
- Hand in final essay

You may use the back of this sheet to brainstorm essay topic/evidence.
